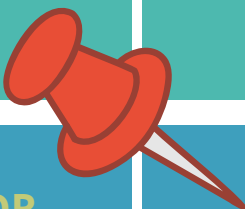

INITIATIVES OR ACTIVITIES WHERE VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING INSTITUTIONS WORK TOGETHER WITH OTHER ORGANIZATIONS, SUCH AS BUSINESSES, INDUSTRY ASSOCIATIONS, OR COMMUNITY GROUPS, TO CREATE JOINT PROJECTS OR PROGRAMS.

THEY OFTEN INVOLVE PARTNERSHIPS OR COLLABORATIONS BETWEEN VET PROVIDERS AND EMPLOYERS TO DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT ALIGN WITH THE NEEDS OF THE INDUSTRY.
